

**District Goal: The district will ensure that the curriculum meets or exceeds Michigan standards and is taught effectively to ensure student success.**

**Smart Goals (In the 2015-16 school year)**

- 1) The District will implement an updated curriculum that will align with state adopted core standards and provide Professional Development to support implementation.
  - a. Curriculum Alignment of district science curriculum with newly adopted state science standards will take place during the 2016-17 school year and a report presented to Curriculum Council in May 2017.
  - b. Principals will evaluate teachers to ensure that district mandated curriculum is being presented effectively through review of teacher lesson plans, observations, and final evaluations. Principal logs will be kept and used when evaluated by the Superintendent.
  
- 2) The District will ensure that the staff is provided professional development to ensure up-to-date best practices for instructional delivery.
  - a. Technology will be utilized in the delivery of lessons when appropriate as documented by teachers and verified by administrators during observations.
  - b. Technology review and updates will occur as part of administrative staff meetings. Recommendations from these meetings will be shared at board meetings during the annual technology update if deemed relevant.
