BEFORE LEAVING FOR SCHOOL

- Parents agree to follow the health guidelines found on the district calendar magnet provided to your family. If the answer is “no” to any of the health guidelines, please keep your child home.
- Parents will monitor the student's temperature and check for any symptoms prior to sending the child to school. Students must have a temperature below 100.4 without the use of fever-reducing medication.

INSTRUCTIONAL TIMES:

Elementary: 8:15-2:45

Secondary: 8:30-2:30

All students will be required to complete benchmark assessments.

HYBRID v. FACE-TO-FACE

While in Hybrid:

- Students will be assigned to Red (Monday/Tuesday) or Blue (Thursday/Friday) groups based on oldest student's last name (A-L=Red, M-Z=Blue) to receive direct instruction in the school setting. Unassigned days will be virtual.
- Wednesday will be a virtual day for all students in all classes to allow for deep-cleaning.
- The Hybrid model will be evaluated by September 30 and every 2 weeks thereafter with a decision on continuation made by the second Wednesday.

While in Face-to-Face:

- Students meet daily (5 days/week) for direct instruction.

THROUGHOUT THE DAY

- All students will learn new expectations (MTSS) aligned to safety protocols.
- Cohorting of classes will be utilized when possible.
- Special education services will be implemented through the IEP process and may include additional accommodations.
- Staff/students will clean desk spaces & materials throughout the day.
- Classes with bathrooms will only use those bathrooms. Common bathrooms will be cleaned throughout the day.
- Students will have their own supplies to be used at their desks to the extent possible.
- Scheduled hand-washing will occur with all students.
- Students are asked to leave personal items at home.

ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL

- Students will be allowed in the elementary buildings at 8:00 am The secondary buildings allow students at 8:15 am.
- All students will enter the building and report directly to their classrooms.
- Parents are asked to remain in their vehicles during drop-off and pick-up.
- While in Phase 4, all students must wear a mask covering their nose and mouth while in the building.
- While in Phase 5, all K-4 students must wear masks in all common areas and when social distancing cannot be maintained in the classroom.
- Upon the completion of school, there will be a staggered release of classes to exit the building to either buses or designated pick-up areas.

FAMILY SUPPORTS

- Free breakfast & lunch available to all students.
- Counselor and/or Social Worker available on-site and to reach out to families at home.

HEALTH & SAFETY INFORMATION

- Mask breaks will be provided throughout the day for students.
- Masks must follow the dress code policy and need to cover the mouth and nose.
- If a student is medically excused from wearing a mask they will be required to wear a “face shield”.
- Visitor access inside the building will be restricted.
- Email communication is strongly encouraged with addresses found at www.chsd.us
- Cleaning throughout the day will follow CDC guidelines.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be provided throughout the building.

TRANSPORTATION

- Bus drivers will be wearing face masks.
- Bus riders will be required to wear a mask for the entire route.
- Buses will be cleaned after each bus route.
- Students will use hand sanitizer while entering the bus.
- Students will be assigned a seat.
- Students will load from the rear forward and maintain social distancing as much as possible.
- Each bus will stagger the release of students.
- Windows will be down to increase air flow, when weather permits.

MEALS & SNACKS

- Students will eat breakfast in the classroom.
- Students will eat lunch socially distanced in the cafeteria.
- Lunches brought from home will be kept in student backpacks.
- Students will be encouraged to bring their own water bottle to school daily. This bottle should be cleaned daily and labeled with the student name.

RECESS

- Students will receive recess breaks throughout the school day based upon their grade level.
- Social distancing will be promoted by recess supervisors.
- Students will not be required to wear their mask outside for recess.
- Sharing of equipment will be limited.

REMOTE WARRIORS (Families choosing full-time virtual)

- Each student who does not have a device at home will be provided a Chromebook.
- Internet connectivity is a family responsibility. (Extenuating circumstances should be shared with the building principal)
- Lessons for all classes will be provided by a Chippewa Hills teacher and will align with classroom instruction.
- All teachers will have their lessons uploaded into Google classroom.
- Required: 2-way content-oriented communication with the teacher at least twice a week.
