Chippewa Hills High School Notification

Due to a shortage of staff due to exposures, Chippewa Hills High School will be placed into virtual mode of instruction beginning Monday, February 15, 2021 and returning to in-person instruction on February 22, 2021. There is not an outbreak at the HS and no students have been required to quarantine following health department protocols. However, multiple exposures has resulted in classrooms not being covered and not enough substitute teachers to cover them. Staff will still be able to provide quality instruction virtually with those expectations occurring throughout the week of February 15.

The Career Center will still be in session so students will be expected to participate/attend to the best of their ability. Shuttle buses will be available at each elementary site just as it occurs on Wednesdays with pick up occurring at the HS following their return. If students need transportation accommodations, please contact the office and we will make the appropriate arrangements.

HS support staff will continue to work either remotely as able or in alternate capacities during this time period. Students needing additional support should reach out to their teachers.

Food will be made available for a Wednesday, February 17, 2021, pick-up at the secondary site from 8:30-3:30 PM in the rear loop by the IS loading dock/practice field (signs posted). This is our normal food distribution model.

Athletic practices and competitions will still be allowed. Other groups that have practices or events will also still be occurring with the advisors making the appropriate arrangements.

All other schools will continue as usual at this time. We are taking these measures to assure the safety of our students as we cope with the shortage of adults to oversee classrooms. I apologize for any inconveniences this may cause for families, but hope you understand why we are taking this approach and can work with us as we do all we can to get students back into the school setting as soon as possible. Thank you Warrior families for your understanding and your continued support during this period of uncertainty.
