Dear Warrior Family,

I must regretfully stop in-person instruction starting tomorrow in our district for the next 2 weeks to address an outbreak that is occurring within our district. We will be virtual only through May 2, returning to in-person on May 3. We have had multiple cases lately, most of which have been brought to school from the community. However, when we have 3 connected cases the health department considers that an outbreak and we need to intervene to reduce the spread. Close contacts have been notified so they can quarantine as prescribed. You do not need to contact the school for details as those that can be shared with impacted individuals have already occurred.

Spring sports will continue to be allowed to practice and compete at this current time, but that is subject to change should the outbreak impact teams. Career Center students will still be allowed to participate at the ISD in their classes. Busing will be as it was previously during virtual instruction with pick ups at each elementary and the secondary site (just like Wednesday).

We are hopeful that students will start to isolate themselves to a greater degree outside of the school setting to minimize the spread. This is an unfortunate situation that I hoped could have been avoided. The spread in our communities continues to increase as the intermingling of our students and their families grows more common. Vaccinations have a huge impact on this quarantine and exposure issue allowing many to still stay at work, in school and involved. I encourage you to get vaccinated if possible to minimize the spread that is impacting us all at this time. When we do return, we will continue to take the proper precautions including masks, hand cleaning/sanitizing and social distancing. I am just asking you to assist in this matter by doing the same within your family. I appreciate all the efforts those are giving at this time to minimize the spread and look forward to being back in-person soon. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we move forward.
